Student Supplies 2019-2020**

The following is a list of supplies required for each student entering Grade 1 in September 2019. Please send these supplies in with your child on the **first day** of school in a gallon size zip lock bag with their name marked on the outside. We will store extras in the classroom to ensure that your child is ready to learn each day.

Please note: Supplies (especially crayons) will need to be replenished as the year progresses.

“Skinny” Expo Dry Erase markers with an eraser on the tip.	3

Soft Pink Eraser (no small novelty erasers please)	2

Scissors - Blunt tip	1

One subject wide ruled spiral notebook. (your choice of color)	1
