*Pre-K & Kindergarten: Full Day: Parishioners \$3,600 Non-Parishioners: \$3,850

Grades 1 to 8:

Parishioner: 1 child \$3,600 2 children \$4,400 3 children \$5,000 4 & over \$5,300

Non-Parishioner: 1 child \$4,600 2 children \$5,500 3 children \$6,600 4 & over \$7,500

*Pre K 3 & 4: If a half day is necessary the tuition is still the same as a full day, since Father is keeping the tuition the same as last year. He also reminds parishioners to continue the weekly \$10 in the collection envelope.
