Dear Parent(s)/Guardians,

As we navigate cautiously through the Third Trimester, I ask that you make note of the following:

- 1- A special word of appreciation to those of you who responded to Father Babowitch's request to enroll your child(ren) for the coming school year (by April 16<sup>th</sup>). This information will facilitate the ordering of books, arrangement of homerooms/teachers, etc. (If you will be moving or transferring your child(ren), please let us know the name of the school and we will prepare the necessary paperwork for you. This "notification of a transfer" includes our Pre-K and Kindergarten children because you may have made other plans for them since the recent registration. This is important because we will then be able to inform those families on our waiting lists. TY!
- 2- We strongly encourage all new coaches, assistant coaches, parents/guardians, etc. to apply for free PA Criminal Record and Child Abuse Clearances if you plan on being a volunteer or chaperone at any time. They are free and good for 5 years. In the Fall, the state will be overwhelmed with applications, so NOW is the time!
- 3- Also, we ask that you please:
  - a) Check out the information and necessary forms regarding our Summer CARES Program which will be posted on the school website as of 4/9/21. No Camp Calvary again this Summer.
  - b) Continue to catch daily updates on the school website, particularly prayer intentions.
  - c) Close out any school fees as soon as possible. ALL tuition and fees must be paid to participate in Moving Up Day and Graduation and to receive report cards and yearbooks.
  - d) The Grade 5 Class Mass scheduled for April 11, will not take place but you are encouraged to attend at your convenience or live-stream the Mass. This particular Sunday is "Divine Mercy Sunday" and this feast is the result of the visions experienced by Saint Faustina, a Polish nun. Jesus appeared to her and asked that she spread devotion to His mercy. His message to her and us is that His capacity for mercy far outweighs our capacity for sin.
  - e) If you have not ordered a Yearbook and wish to do so, please let us know ASAP as the proofs will be mailed out soon. TY!

In closing, we appreciate your attention to the above and hope you are reading the attachments on the website. Thank you for your consistent support and encouragement. I am especially and personally grateful for your Mass cards, prayers, and kind thoughts over the recent passing of my Dad. All were most comforting.
