Emergency Kits: We ask that all our students have Emergency kits in the school building. These kits would help us care for your children in an emergency until you can arrive to collect them. The Emergency Kit is part of our school supply list. If your child does not have an Emergency Kit at the school, please, deliver one to your child's teacher as soon as possible. Thank you!

Bottle & Can Drive: We have blue Bottledrop bags for bottles & cans. If you would like a blue bag stop by the office. You can put your bottles & cans in the blue bag and then drop it off at the school. We will deliver it to Bottledrop. This saves us hours in sorting time.

Medications: Whenever a child has any kind of medication – including over-the-counter medications, Chapstick, and cough drops – we must have a Medication Authorization form filled out and on file in the school office. According to Archdiocesan policy, it is not sufficient to send a note in with your child, and medication must be in its original container.
