Parent/Student Handbook – School Directory: The 2021-2022 Parent/Student Handbook and Directory is being sent home today if you did not receive it at the mandatory Parents Club Meeting. **Please read the Handbook and return the signature pages by October 7.**

Lost & Found: Our Lost & Found will be in the uniform closet in a tub marked “Lost & Found”. If your child has lost a clothing item, please, check there. If items have not been picked up from the “Lost & Found” by the 1st of the month they will be disposed of. **PLEASE put your child’s name on all facemasks, jackets, sweaters and sweatshirts.**

Mass: We are so happy that we will be able to attend Mass each Friday of the school year beginning on October 1st. Please make sure your child comes to school on time. We ring the bell at 8 AM and head over to the church. We lock the school door at that time, students will need to go over to the church and find their class. Each class will be assigned an area to sit with their teacher and classmates. Parents are welcome to join us for Mass. We are encouraging our students to sit with their class. Masks are required for Mass. Our shepherd, Archbishop Alexander Sample, has requested that we wear mask at all indoor faith gatherings.

Emergency Kits: We ask that all our students have Emergency kits in the school building. These kits would help us care for your children in an emergency until you can arrive to collect them. The Emergency Kit is part of our school supply list. If your child does not have an Emergency Kit at the school, please, deliver one to your child’s teacher as soon as possible. Thank you!

Water Bottles: Please send a water bottle to school with your child(ren). No one is allowed to drink directly out of the drinking fountains. They are allowed to fill their water bottles at the drinking fountains. We want our students to stay hydrated; especially, when they are running around on warm days. 😊

Scrip: One of our fundraisers is our scrip program. We have Benefit Mobile which is an app for your smart phone. You may use your credit card or debit your checking account with Benefit Mobile. It is easy to use and always available to you! We are listed as Sacred Heart School Gervais.

We also have physical scrip cards available in the school office. Email Mrs. Schnurbusch and she can have an order ready for you when you pick up your children. The scrip form is available on our website at <https://school.shstl.org/scrip>.

Bottle & Can Drive: Every 1st Friday of the month we collect bottles and cans. This money goes into the Parents Club budget and helps pay for many of the activities of the Parents Club. Just a few items we raise money for are: Teacher Appreciation, Librarian Appreciation, Outdoor School for the 6th Graders, 1st Communion gifts, and Graduation gifts. We use blue BottleDrop bags! If you would like a bag just email the school office and we will hand it to your student as they leave the building. You may either return the bag to us or drop it off at any BottleDrop location!
