Print receipt or write your order number on a piece of paper and have your child(ren) bring it to the photographer.

Called to Protect: Any returning volunteers will need to complete "It Happened to Me" which is an online course. There is a flyer in your Wednesday envelope.

Sweatshirt Order: A Sacred Heart sweatshirt order form is in the Wednesday envelope. If you would like to place an order please turn in the order form with check or cash by Monday, September 22.

Lunch/Milk: Remember to pack a lunch and snacks for your student. Our hot lunch program is on hold until further notice. We will sell milk each day to our students with chocolate milk available the 1st week of each month. Do not send items that need to be microwaved with your student. We have one microwave and 100 students. Milks are .30 and we bill you at the end of each month.

Medication: Whenever a child has any kind of medication – including over-the-counter medications, Chapstick, and cough drops – we must have a **Medication Authorization form** filled out and on file in the school office. According to Archdiocesan policy, it is not sufficient to send a note in with your child, and medication must be **in its original container**. Bottle & Can Drive: Every 1st Friday of the month we collect bottles and cans. This money goes into the Parents Club budget and helps pay for many of the activities of the Parents Club. If you would like a bag just email the school office and we will hand it to your student as they leave the building. You may either return the bag to us or drop it off at any BottleDrop location!
