Administration of Medicine While at School:

Please remember, according to the Diocesan Policy #5141:

1. The school personnel will administer no prescription medication without the Medication Consent Form and the Physician Order for Medication. These forms are obtained from our [website](#) or the school office. After the form has been filled out and returned to school, the appropriate representative of the school will administer the medication. **ALL medications must be in the original container.**
2. Prescription medication to be given out in school must include the following information:
 - Child's full name
 - Name of drug and dosage
 - Time to be given
 - Physician's name
3. **Non-prescription medications must be in the original container and accompanied by the School's Medication Consent Form before administering the medication.** Cough drops are considered a medication. Cough drops on a stick are not permitted.
4. It is the responsibility of the students, if appropriate, not school personnel, to get their medication at the designated time.
5. Band-aids can be obtained from the teacher or the school office. Students requiring more than a band-aid for a wound will get proper attention from the school office; however, the school personnel cannot administer any antiseptic sprays or ointments on wounds unless directed by signed physician order or direct permission of the parent/guardian.

****Every effort should be made to administer medication at home.**
