

**Pastoral Council & Finance Council**  
**Joint Meeting**  
**August 6, 2019 Minutes**

**Present:** Rev. Jazdzewski, Becky Adamski-Krische, Elaine Carlson, Kris Miller, Chris Woodford, Matt Krische, Dan Marx, John Durtschi, Sarah Gordee, and Sharon Sliwka. Laura Miller was excused.

The meeting was called to order by Chris Woodford on August 6, 2019, at 7:13 PM.

Rev. Jazdzewski read this week's Gospel and opened with a prayer.

**Approval of Minutes:** Minutes/notes from the July meeting were approved via email, edited, and posted on the website.

The majority of the meeting was to review the strategic plan and move toward implementing changes. Please refer to the final Strategic Plan document dated August 8, 2019, for details.

Items that still need discussion and decisions: When/If Parish Center becomes vacant, where will the Bazaar/Fundraisers be? Where will Religious Ed be held? What will the Parish do with the vacated building? Regarding Mass times: seasonal usage of one church for weekend Masses and the other for daily Masses; both churches for Holy Days, weddings, funerals. Where will Deanery Adoration Chapel go? The changing Mass schedule and locations is an effort to form a cohesive community that wants to celebrate and participate together and will happen this September or October.

Catholic Charities relocation to the SP Rectory is still not definite. Parish Offices can be relocated to either the SH Convent/Catholic Charities building or to SP Rectory.

The plan is to make modifications as we go, based on feedback from parishioners. The plan has moving parts to it. The PC wants feedback from the parish. In addition to the listing of council names and contact info, a council email will be set up to entertain more questions and comments. The first listening/information session will be held on August 25 following 10:30 AM Mass in the Sacred Heart Church undercroft. This plan is the direction the council want to go but changes are fluid and input from parishioners is important. Change can be difficult but it spurs new beginnings. There is a desire to make these changes in a positive light, not out of fear.

Finalized pamphlet will be published this week. Rev. Jazdzewski will introduce changes, both council members and Rebuilt members will attend different Masses to distribute. Council email will be created. Notice of the informational meeting will be published in the bulletin.

Meeting was closed with a prayed at 8:40 PM.

Next meeting is scheduled for the Tuesday after Labor Day, September 3, 2019.
