The Class of 1940 Scholarship provides a “payback” from Salina Central High 1940 graduates to future graduates of their alma mater. Funds to start this scholarship were donated by Class President Jack Moore, who invited other members of the class to join him in providing funds for Central students who are in need of financial assistance to continue their education. The amount of the Class of 1940 Scholarship is \$250, awarded annually.

APPLICATION DUE DATE: March 1, annually

A selection committee—consisting of the senior counselor, principal, and two teachers—will name the recipient. The committee will notify the Salina Education Foundation of the name of the chosen recipient no later than April 15.

ELIGIBILITY:

The Class of 1940 Scholarship is awarded to a graduate of Salina Central High who plans to attend a Kansas college or university. The recipient must be an excellent student and have test scores that indicate a good chance for success in a higher education environment. Financial need will be considered in the committee’s decision.
