Mock Trial offers students an opportunity to learn public speaking skills through a concentrated focus on the American judicial system, which places a premium on effective communication and persuasion through well-reasoned arguments. This focus provides students with an exciting and challenging medium for the development of speaking skills.

- Members of the team will learn the legal process and trial procedure.
- Students will prepare and present a trial from the perspective of both the prosecution and defense.
- At the end of the program, parents will be invited to watch the students in action as they formally present their case in front of a judge.
