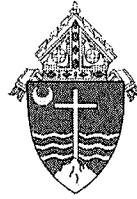

## **Wednesday, March 31, 2021**

### **Online devotion with Bishop Malloy**

During the widespread stay-at-home orders, Bishop Malloy offered a brief reflection on the Gospel every Wednesday at 12 Noon. With those orders lifted and the Lenten season ending, Bishop Malloy will conclude those online devotions in Holy Week. ## **Holy Thursday, April 1, 2021**

### **11 a.m., Chrism Mass**

Bishop David Malloy will concelebrate the Chrism Mass with only priests of the diocese at the Cathedral of St. Peter, Rockford. This holy Mass commemorates the great mystery of the institution of the priesthood. It is also the time when the *Oil for the Holy Chrism*, the *Oil of the Sick* and the *Oil of the Catechumens* are blessed and distributed. At the conclusion of the liturgy, the holy oils will be distributed to one of the priests of each diocesan parish or institution.
