### Blessed Among Us – St. Thomas Apostle

The activities of Thomas post-Pentecost are uncertain. According to early legends, he engaged in a great missionary venture that took him as far as the south of India, where he was reportedly martyred. In fact, when Portuguese explorers in the sixteenth century landed on the coast of southern India they found in place a Christian community that attributed its origins to the evangelization of the doubting apostle. To this day their descendants call themselves St. Thomas Christians. *“Thomas's unbelief has benefited our faith more than the belief of other disciples; it is because he attained faith through physical touch that we are confirmed in the faith beyond all doubt.”* - St. Gregory the Great on St. Thomas
