Saint Kateri Tekakwitha

Saint Kateri, the Lily of the Mohawks, is a stunning example of courage and sanctity. The first Native American to be canonized, she suffered in a variety of ways, and yet her life story is filled with luminous examples of her devout love and faithfulness for God. Saint Kateri died quite young (at age 24 in 1860), and yet her story continues to move, bless, and inspire countless others. The life of Saint Kateri is remembered and honored on July 14.

Humane Vitae (“Of Human Life”) is the papal encyclical of Blessed Paul VI released on July 25, 1968, which provides a beautiful and coherent teaching about God's plan for married love and the transmission of human life. This year marks the 50th anniversary of the issuance of this document and during this anniversary year, all Catholics are urged to read the document and grasp its meaning and purpose and to rediscover the splendor of the matrimonial call to be open to human life.
