### St. Gregory the Great

St. Gregory was born to a patrician Roman family that had provided two previous popes to the Church. He first pursued a career in civil service, achieving the office of prefect of Rome. When his father died, Gregory put aside “worldly concerns” and turned his estate into a monastery. In 579 he was called to serve the Church in a number of sensitive positions, concluding in 590 with his election as pope. He left his mark on the spiritual life of the Church through regulation of the liturgy and promotion of plainsong, choral music (later known as Gregorian chant). He encouraged the flowering of monasticism (writing a popular biography of St. Benedict) and sponsored the first successful mission to the British Isles. In light of these accomplishments he was honored as Pope Gregory “Magnus” – the Great. He preferred to be called “Servant of the servants of God.” *Blessed Among Us – Give Us This Day*
