Collection for Formation of Permanent Deacons

This weekend there will be a special collection for the formation of permanent deacons in the Archdiocese of St. Louis. This collection relieves some of their financial burden for studies to become a deacon. Since 1977, 465 men have been ordained as permanent deacons in the Archdiocese. There are 197 active deacons ordained for the Archdiocese and 82 retired deacons. There are 44 men in formation at this time. Deacons serve in parishes, hospitals, archdiocesan agencies, and other organizations. During formation and after ordination, deacons offer their time, personal gifts and material goods to build up the Church in the Archdiocese without compensation. Saint John XXIII's Story

Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli was the firstborn son of a farming family in Sotto il Monte, Italy. After his ordination in 1904, Fr. Roncalli returned to Rome for canon law studies.

Named a cardinal and appointed patriarch of Venice in 1953, he was finally a residential bishop. A month short of entering his 78th year, Cardinal Roncalli was elected pope, taking the name John after his father and the patron of Rome's cathedral, St. John Lateran. His most famous encyclicals were *Mother and Teacher* (1961) and *Peace on Earth* (1963). Pope John XXIII enlarged the membership in the College of Cardinals and made it more international.

“Good Pope John” died on June 3, 1963. Saint John Paul II beatified him in 2000, and Pope Francis canonized him in 2014.
