Stewardship Bible Reflections

“Blessed are you when people hate you...exclude and insult you, and denounce your name...on account of the Son of Man.” (Luke 6:22) All of us have been in situations when someone has made a negative comment or joke about God or our Catholic faith. How did you respond? Did you stay silent or pretend to go along with the crowd because you didn’t want to cause waves and then, later, you felt bad? Know that God is with you all the time, the Holy Spirit will put the right words in your mouth.



St. Robert Southwell

Robert Southwell was born in Norfolk and studied at the English college in Douai, France. At eighteen, he was accepted by the Jesuits. Five years later he stole into England and embarked on a clandestine ministry that lasted six years. During this time he achieved both notoriety and literary fame through the publication of religious poems and a number of tracts defending the loyalty of his fellow Catholics. Inevitably, he was captured. For three years he was held without charge in the Tower, subjected repeatedly to torture. Eventually, he was tried and sentenced to death. Before mounting the gallows, he addressed the crowd: “I am come hither to play out the last act of this poor life...” Quoting St. Paul, he said, “Whether we live or die, we belong to the Lord.” *Blessed Among Us Give Us This Day*
