Felix Varela, a Catholic priest and theologian, was born in Havana, Cuba. In 1821 he was elected a delegate to the Spanish Cortes in Madrid, where he introduced bills calling for Cuban independence from Spain and another for

the abolition of slavery. As a result of such seditious talk he was forced to flee Spain and go into exile. Settling in New York City, he spent many years in pastoral work. Still passionately loyal to his homeland, he began a Spanish-language newspaper, which became a voice for Cuban independence. Varela wrote a book that promoted the value of religion as a guardian of liberty, while at the same time challenging the Church to embrace the spirit of liberty and democracy. Varela died on February 25, 1853. In 1911 his remains were removed to Cuba, where his grave was honored by Cuban patriots of all political tendencies. *Blessed Among Us*
