Lenten Regulations

Ash Wednesday (Wednesday March 6, 2019) and Good Friday (April 19, 2019) are days of *abstinence* for all Catholics *over the age of 14*. On these two days, *fast*, as well as *abstinence*, is also obligatory for those *from the ages of 18-59*. Abstinence means refraining from meat. Fast means one full meal a day, with two smaller meals and nothing between meals (liquids are permitted). No Catholic will lightly excuse himself or herself from this obligation. **All Fridays in Lent** are days of *abstinence* from meat.

Pilgrimage to Cathedral Basilica

The Shrine to Our Lady of the Rosary will sponsor a pilgrimage to the Cathedral Basilica of Saint Louis on Friday, March 15, to view the relic of the uncorrupted heart of Saint John Vianney. The Knights of Columbus are sponsoring the tour of the relic across the United States as a means of healing the wounds in the Church. A bus will leave the parking lot of Saint Joseph's at 10:00 A.M. After leaving the Cathedral Basilica at 3 P.M. there will be a stop for dinner at the Cracker Barrel in Herculaneum. The bus will return to the parking lot at Saint Joseph's between 5:30 and 6:00 P.M. The program for the Cathedral is: Holy Mass at 12:05 P.M. followed by veneration of the relic.

The cost for the bus is \$20. Each person will pay for their own dinner.
