Blessed Maria Schinina

Maria Schinina was born to a wealthy noble family in Ragusa, Sicily. In her early life she had no particular concern for religious matters. However, the death of her father, when she was twenty-one, prompted her to reflect more deeply about the meaning of life. She began to visit the homes of her poor neighbors to see what she could do to alleviate their suffering. Italy, at the time, was in the throes of the struggle for national unification, and the sufferings of war found their way to her doorstep. Her work extended to tending to the wounded and prisoners of war. She found support from her bishop and with his blessing and several companions she formed the Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Maria died on June 11, 1910. She was beatified in 1990. *Give Us This Day*
