St. Candida Maria of Jesus

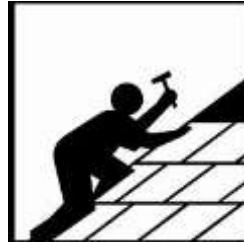
Raised in a poor family in Salamanca, Spain, St. Candida spent her early life working as a maid. But she felt herself called to something more. On Good Friday in 1868, while praying in church, she received a vision of Christ, with the Blessed Mother beside him, who

instructed her to found a congregation for the education of young girls. With the help of a Jesuit priest, she set about putting her plan in motion. With little formal education herself, she organized a school for poor girls in the city. In 1871 she and five companions took vows in a new congregation, the Daughters of Jesus, and she became superior general. The congregation spread throughout Spain, and it was officially recognized in 1901. They drew their spirituality from the *Spiritual Exercises* of St. Ignatius. Eventually her sisters traveled the globe, including the United States. Candida died on August 9, 1912, and was canonized by Pope Benedict XVI in 2010.

The Pastor’s Workshop



I mentioned last weekend to the parishioners at St. Joseph that we placed a new shingled roof on the church at Bonne Terre. With lightning protection and new copper flashing upgraded, it comes to a cost of \$42,000. The same

firm that did the roof at the rectory about 4 years ago did this work. The lightning protection needed some upgrades as well. You may remember 2 years ago that we were hit by lightning. The cost of a new organ that was damaged and other items affected by the lightning strike, came to more than \$42,000. Our insurance coverage was helpful but we still had to assist in the effort. As you come into town from Hwy 67 you’ll see our steeple above the tree line. It’s one of the tallest spots in the area. Lightening seems to recognize the highest points, so we needed to upgrade our protection. The previous roof shingles were cracked, and the old flashing was allowing water to come down and pool between into the walls. I think you can easily identify the many places around the church that water damage has invaded our prayer space. I believe this new roof should be helpful as we consider the future painting of the church. With some savings and the generous help of the bingo account we were able to cover the roof cost. (Thank you Jesus). But in end, your stewardship matters.
