The Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius

4. *Respond to God in Dialogue*

Is there any one area on which you are being nudged to focus your attention, to pray more seriously, to take action? Discuss this with Jesus.

5. *Help and Guidance for Tomorrow*

Ask God for your needs for tomorrow.
