He broke his leg a few weeks ago and he originally thought he would be able to continue with our 40 Hours, but as time gets closer, he realizes that will not be possible. We wish Archbishop Jackels a speedy recovery. He will be here for our 40 Hours next year: March 17-19, 2019.

During the Lenten Season, we will have Masses on Monday nights at 5:30 pm followed by Stations of the Cross. Due to the severity of the flu season this year, and at the recommendation of archdiocesan leadership, we will not distribute the Precious Blood at any Mass. We will also not shake hands during the Sign of Peace. Please use good common sense when not feeling well. If you are sick please stay home and take care of yourself. The news says this is one of the deadliest flu seasons in many years and that the peak has not been reached. The above practices are in effect until there is indication the season is no longer a threat to human health and well-being. – Archbishop Jackels
