1. True or False Ordinary Time comprises two periods of time: one begins the day after the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord and ends the day before Ash Wednesday and the other begins the Monday after Pentecost and continues until the Saturday before the First Sunday of Advent.

2. Did you know? Green vestments are worn by the Priest during Ordinary Time. This color symbolizes hope, life, and anticipation and is used during this season in which we focus on the Lord's three-year public ministry, His teachings and miracles, and serves as a reminder that the mission of the church is to share the hope and life of Christ with the world.
