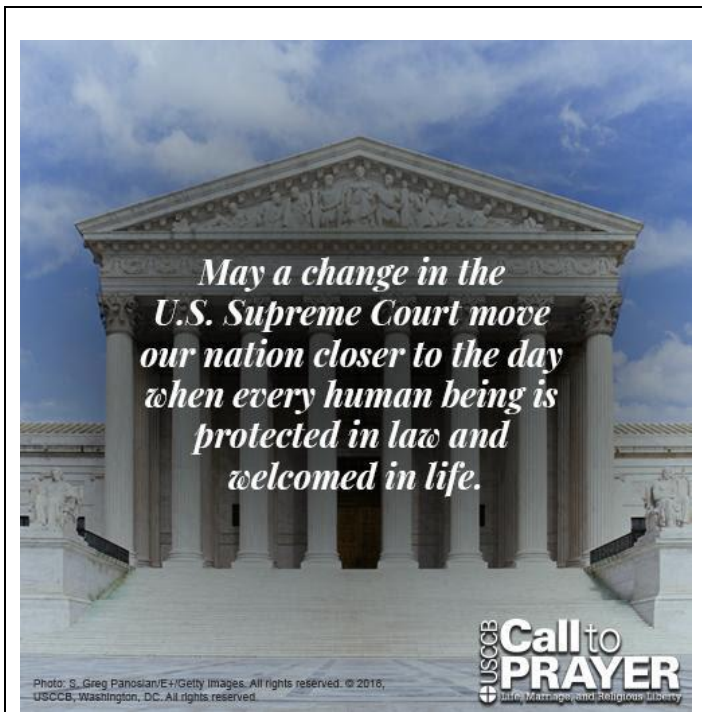

“Hospice of Dubuque will soon be sponsoring two six-week bereavement support groups.
