# Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, July 18, 2021

#### From Fr. Mark

"When Jesus saw the vast crowd, his heart was moved with pity for them, for they were like sheep without a shepherd; and he began to teach them many things." (Mark 6:34)

Today's readings have a recurring theme: God is the shepherd, who will gather the remnant of his flock, and bring them back to their meadow. We believe Jesus, God's Son, is the Good Shepherd, and Jesus in turn will appoint others to shepherd the flock. We are the sheep, and Jesus, through the power of the Holy Spirit, appoints shepherds to help nurture and protect us.

We are glad that Archbishop Michael Jackels tends the flock of the Archdiocese. And we are glad that he ordained 10 permanent deacons last weekend. Two of them are from our pastorate: Mark Otting and Dan Kurt. Last Sunday, Deacon Dan preached the homily at the 10 AM mass, and afterwards baptized his granddaughter Isla. At the 10 Am Mass this weekend, Deacon Mark Otting will preach. We are glad to have these two men serve our pastorate.

In today's Gospel, Jesus and his apostles tried to get away for a rest, but the people soon found them. Jesus responded with compassion, and began to teach the people. We are glad that our Good Shepherd watches over us.
