

Parish Council Meeting St. Matthias Parish

September 10, 2019

The utilities will have to be moved, concrete removal and concrete added.
- The sound system will be looked into yet by Mike Mair as complaints were reported.
- The cement in front and around the sacristy that is flaking along with deck pad area in front of church will wait till next fiscal year as the garage is the priority.
