Buildings and Grounds:

- Kevin will check on the status of the steeple louvres repair.
- The Gary Kelchen family requests to build a 16' x 20' meat cutter pavilion on the current site in memory of Gary. All materials and labor will be provided by the family. Some electrical work may be financed by the parish. They will submit a plan to the council. The council graciously accepts the donation in Gary's memory.
- Rectory: The Roe family will be moving out of the rectory this Fall. They will leave the dishwasher they purchased in exchange for cleaning/replacing the dining room carpet. They will leave the dryer which works only on "timed" and will discard the original dryer. All other parish furniture will be left. Nathan will reseed the garden area in April if we wish. He also noted that the dining room is cold in winter because of no insulation between the garage and the dining room floor. A couple of windows may need replacement and a water pressure tank is needed in the house because when the cattle are using water, little is available in the house. The council requested to tour the house sometime before the family leaves.
