Joint Council Notes

The meeting opened with prayer and reflection by Father Mark. Aquin Report by Deacon Ray Noonan. See handout for complete report. The allocation breakdown between Parishes for Aquin subsidy and Pastorate expenses was shared as well as the Aquin budget for the 2021-22 school year.

\$9296 was collected and distributed for the Storm Relief Collection. Harvest of Blessings collection has been extended until November 22.

Faith Formation: There will be bulletin inserts. All are encouraged to use FORMED. A Mother Teresa booklet will be given out at Christmas Masses.

Father Mark's Report: After the governor's latest rules on Covid, Archbishop Jackels responded saying the parishes are already following the rules. The Christmas Mass schedule will be the same as previous years with the exception of a 6:30 Mass instead of 6pm on Christmas Eve at St. Martin's. A Reconciliation schedule will be published in the bulletin. Soon there will be video equipment in St. Martin's Church to livestream Masses.

St. Peter's Minutes

Motion by Joan and second by Jay to approve minutes from the September 29 meeting with a correction listing Jay Manternach among those present. (Sorry, Jay) All ayes.

Financials: There was a \$73,879.08 total gain in accounts over the last quarter. Kevin will ask the finance committee (Marcie Roe, Shelley Schockemoehl, Jill Ehlers) to determine whether to reinvest the total or a portion, or to put it in a holding account. Determination must be made by November13. Motion by Jordan and second by Ashley to approve the October financials. All ayes.

Deacon Ray Noonan asked for approval of St. Peter's portion of the 2021-22 Aquin budget, \$65,353. Approved by concensus.

2021 Mid Winter Fling: The committee presented two possible alternatives. Motion by Jordan and second by Ralph to skip it this time and send a letter to parishioners informing them of the decision and asking them to do what they can to get current with their regular giving. All ayes.

After discussion, it was decided with Father Mark to have Mass at 6:30pm followed by confessions at St. Peters on December 8, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception.

Julie shared a small sample package of religious items which the council decided to prepare for each family in the parish. These will be distributed by council members and others as much as possible. Some will probably need to be mailed. This is in place of the usual parish Christmas gathering, letting parishioners know they are being remembered at this time.

Kevin and Janet donated a new hand dryer for the men's restroom. Herb Manternach will install.

Motion by Jay and second by Jordan to adjourn at 8:30pm. All ayes.
