<b>PENETENTIAL RITE</b>	Recited		<i>Priest does penitential rite: <b>Lord have mercy, Christ have mercy, Lord have mercy.</b></i>
<b>GLORY TO GOD</b>	<b>No Gloria in Advent</b>		Immediately following the Penitential Right.
<b>RESPONSORIAL PSALM</b>	<b>Respond and Acclaim pg 4</b>		<b>Cantor</b> will announce immediately following the 1 <sup>st</sup> reading
<b>GOSPEL ACCLAMATION</b>	<b>Alleluia! Respond and Acclaim pg 5</b>		Following the 2 <sup>nd</sup> reading - start the Gospel acclamation when the Priest stands and says – “let us rise for the gospel”.
<b>PREPARATION OF THE GIFTS</b>	<b>Turn to Me BB 6-5-0</b>		Follows the prayers of the faithful read by the Lector with a short prayer by the priest.
<b>HOLY, HOLY</b> <i>Mass of Spirit and Grace</i>	<b>BB 9-3-5</b>		When Father says: “... <b>with the choirs of heaven, we cry out to your majesty on earth and without end we acclaim...</b> ” (or something similar)
<b>MEMORIAL ACCLAMATION</b> <i>Mass of Spirit and Grace</i>	<b>When We Eat This Bread BB 9-3-7</b>		Father will genuflect after raising the cup and say: “ <b>The mystery of faith:</b> ”
<b>AMEN</b> <i>Mass of Spirit and Grace</i>	<b>BB 9-3-9</b>		Father will raise the cup and sing: “ <b>Through Him with Him, and in Him, O God, almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honor is yours, for ever and ever:</b> ”
<b>LAMB OF GOD</b> <i>Mass of Spirit and Grace</i>	<b>BB 9-4-0</b>		Immediately following the “Sign of Peace”
<b>COMMUNION 1</b>	<b>To You, O Lord BB 7-5-0</b>		Start as soon as the cantor and accompanist are back from communion.
<b>COMMUNION 2</b>	<b>Make Your Home in Me BB 6-1-5</b>		Immediately following the 1 <sup>st</sup> communion hymn if needed. Plan to wrap up as Father sits following communion.
<b>CLOSING</b>	<b>Come, Thou Long-Expected Jesus BB 4-0</b>		Priest will give the final blessing. Cantor will announce the closing hymn.
