GLORY TO GOD <i>Heritage Mass</i>	Glory to God BB 8-8-8		Immediately following the Penitential Right.
RESPONSORIAL PSALM	Respond and Acclaim pg 156		Cantor will announce immediately following the 1 st reading
GOSPEL ACCLAMATION	Alleluia! Respond and Acclaim pg 157		Following the 2 nd reading - start the Gospel acclamation when the Priest stands and says – “let us rise for the gospel”.
PREPARATION OF THE GIFTS	Jesu, Joy of Our Desiring BB 4-0-9		Follows the prayers of the faithful read by the Lector with a short prayer by the priest.
HOLY, HOLY <i>Heritage Mass</i>	BB 8-8-9		When Father says: “... <i>with the choirs of heaven, we cry out to your majesty on earth and without end we acclaim...</i> ” (or something similar)
MEMORIAL ACCLAMATION <i>Heritage Mass</i>	Save Us, Savior BB 8-9-2		Father will genuflect after raising the cup and say: “ <i>The mystery of faith:</i> ”
AMEN <i>Heritage Mass</i>	BB 8-9-3		Father will raise the cup and sing: “ <i>Through Him with Him, and in Him, O God, almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honor is yours, for ever and ever:</i> ”
LAMB OF GOD <i>Heritage Mass</i>	BB 8-9-4		Immediately following the “Sign of Peace”
COMMUNION 1	Unless a Grain of Wheat BB 5-0-4		Start as soon as the cantor and accompanist are back from communion.
COMMUNION 2	For The Healing of the Nations BB 7-3-2		Immediately following the 1 st communion hymn if needed. Plan to wrap up as Father sits following communion.
CLOSING	Hail, Redeemer, King Divine BB 7-2-1		Priest will give the final blessing. Cantor will announce the closing hymn.
