PK3 – Kindergarten

1st-4th Grade

- Teachers will send a weekly newsletter via email with skills and standards being covered each week.
- All assignments will be posted in Parent Portals and through email. Please check daily for assigned work and due dates.
- All completed work should be submitted in accordance with each teacher's directions.

5th-7th Grade

- Teachers will send a weekly newsletter via email with skills and standards being covered each week.
- All assignments will be posted in Google Classroom. Students should check their Google Classroom daily for assigned work and due dates.
- All completed work should be submitted in accordance with each teacher's directions.
