

PARENT/STUDENT AGREEMENT IN REGARD TO ONLINE/VIRTUAL Counseling
Archdiocese Required Consent

I/we, the parent(s) or legal guardian (hereinafter referred to as "Parent") of _____, and _____ ("Student") make the following agreement with _____ ("School") in regard to online/virtual Counseling provided by the School:

- 1) "Parent" agrees that, in addition to and/or in lieu of in-person counseling provided by School or in partnership with a third party, that Students may at times participate in online/virtual counseling provided by School.
- 2) At all times during any period of online/virtual counseling, "Parent" and Student further agree to abide by any and all policies, rules and/or regulations of School, including but not limited to those set forth in the School's handbook.
- 3) In addition, as a specific consideration of allowing Student to participate in online/virtual counseling provided by School and, further, in consideration of the privacy rights of Student and other students and any teachers or educators of School, "Parent" and Student agree not to copy or record or send and/or re-transmit any online/virtual counseling, in any form, to any other person or entity or file or place or post any online/virtual counseling on any site on the internet or on any form of social media.
- 4) The only exception to Provision 3 above, occurs in those instances with the specific authorization of the school counselor and/or school leadership in furtherance of intervention. In such instance, the recording may not be shared or sent and/or re-transmitted, in any form, to any person or entity or file or placed or posted on any site on the internet or on any form of social media other than that specifically designated by school counselor and/or school leadership for that session. Once the session is complete and completion acknowledged by the school counselor and/or school leadership, any recording of the session involved must be permanently deleted from all electronic storage.
- 5) "Parent" and Student understand that failure to abide by this provision may result in Student being barred from any further online/virtual counseling and/or any other discipline deemed appropriate, at the sole discretion of School, including but not limited to expulsion from School.
- 6) "Parent" and Student understand and agree that although School is offering online/virtual counseling at this time, School may terminate the option for online/virtual counseling at any time and require personal attendance of Student at school for continued sessions. Additionally, School may in its sole discretion from time to time impose additional requirements not contained herein or otherwise modify this Agreement as a condition to Student's continued participation in online/virtual counseling.
- 7) The provisions of this Agreement shall supersede any provisions of the School handbook or policies to the extent they may contradict.
