The letters stand for **R**ite of **C**hristian Initiation of **A**dults

It is how adults are initiated into the Faith of the Roman Catholic Church

It's also a way for those who are already members of the Church to be refreshed and renewed in Faith

It was part of the renewal of the life of the Church from the **Second Vatican Council**

RCIA introduces people into a relationship with the Lord Jesus and the Church, and helps form us as disciples of the Lord

It is not some kind of 'night class' ... but it is a weekly evening commitment (and this year will be held at St. Peter's)

There is no exam at the end ...

... but there are things called '**Scrutinies**' (during Lent) which are intensely focussed prayers for those who want to become members of the Church

RCIA is not primarily about learning 'stuff' or information although a lot of time is spent looking at Biblical texts, praying, reflecting and learning all sorts of useful 'stuff' about what Catholics believe and do!

Every RCIA is a unique and wonderful experience of friendship and faith
