Jesus gets drawn into the argument that went on between the Saducees and the Pharisees regarding the resurrection. The Saducees did not believe in the resurrection; the Pharisees did. In his argument the Saducee used the tactic known as 'reductio ad absurdum'.



Jesus used the man's insincere inquiry as an opportunity to deliver a genuine teaching. The first thing he did was to challenge the assumption that the after-life is just a continuation of this life with some extras thrown in. It is a completely new mode of existence.

Then he went on to use another argument to support belief in the resurrection of the dead. God is known as a God of the living. But he is also known as the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. This means that the patriarchs must be still living.

WIADOMOŚCI POLSKIEJ WSPÓLNOTY W LIVINSTON



Drodzy, z księgi Machabejskiej, opisującej męczeństwo za wiarę weźmy ten mały fragment: *całe jego otoczenie zdumiewało się odwagą młodzieńca, jak za nic miał cierpienia* - by sobie uświadomić jak wielu młodych ludzi oddało życie za naszą Ojczyznę i za naszą wiarę. Dzisiaj - w 101 rocznicę odzyskania Niepodległości - podziękujmy za wszystkich, którzy sprawili, że cieszymy się wolnością w Polsce i w Europie. Autor listu do Tesaloniczan napisał te słowa także do nas: *Niechaj Pan skieruje serca wasze ku miłości Bożej i cierpliwości Chrystusowej.*

W listopadzie modlimy się w **WYPOMINKOWEJ LITANII IMION**, wierząc, że *Jezus Chrystus jest Pierworodnym umarłych, Jemu chwała i moc na wieki wieków.* W dyskusji o zmartwychwstaniu na pytanie saduceuszów Jezus odpowiedział, że wierni zmarli: *są równi aniołom i są dziećmi Bożymi, będąc uczestnikami zmartwychwstania. (...) Bóg nie jest Bogiem umarłych, lecz żywych; wszyscy bowiem dla Niego żyją.* Módlmy się za naszych Bohaterów Niepodległości, ale także za naszych Zmarłych Siostry i Braci – z wiarą którą przypomina pełen nadziei refren psalmu: *Gdy zmartwychwstanę, będę widział Boga.* Dziękuję wszystkim Dzieciom i ich Rodzicom za aktywny udział w Gali Wszystkich Świętych – ks. Piotr
