*Gospel*.....LK 4:1-13

Filled with the Holy Spirit, Jesus returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the desert for forty days, to be tempted by the devil. He ate nothing during those days, and when they were over he was hungry.

The devil said to him, "If you are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread." Jesus answered him, "It is written, *One does not live on bread alone.*" Then he took him up and showed him all the kingdoms of the world in a single instant. The devil said to him,

*Evangelio*.....Lc 4, 1-13

Parents are requested to accompany the Confirmations students to be at the Church at least 30 minutes early on these days.

The Stations of the Cross are a 14-step Catholic devotion that commemorates Jesus Christ's last day on Earth as a man. The 14 devotions, or stations, focus on specific events of His last day, beginning with His condemnation. The stations are commonly used as a mini pilgrimage as the individual moves from station to station. At each station, the individual recalls and meditates on a specific event from Christ's last day. Specific prayers are recited, then the individual moves to the next station until all 14 are complete.

Las estaciones de la Cruz son una devoción católica de 14 pasos que conmemora el último día de Jesucristo en la tierra como hombre. Las 14 devociones, o estaciones, se centran en eventos específicos de su último día, comenzando con su condena. Las estaciones se utilizan comúnmente como un mini peregrinaje como el individuo se mueve de la estación a la estación. En cada estación, el individuo recuerda y medita en un acontecimiento específico del último día de Cristo. Se recitan oraciones específicas, luego el individuo se traslada a la siguiente estación hasta que los 14 estén completos.

10th Station: Jesus's clothes taken away

11th Station: Jesus is nailed to the cross

12th Station: Jesus dies on the cross

13th Station: The body of Jesus is taken down from the cross

14th Station: Jesus is laid in the tomb
