YOUR VOICE IS NEEDED TO OPPOSE PHYSICIAN-ASSISTED SUICIDE IN MASSACHUSETTS!

Recently the Physician Assisted Suicide (PAS) bills in the Massachusetts legislature were reported "favorably" by the Joint Committee on Public Health. This is the first time the bills have received a favorable recommendation from a committee. The two bills were also amended slightly and merged into one bill (S.2745, "An Act relative to end of life options"). It has now been assigned to the Health Care Finance Committee for its review.

It is not to late too stop this legislation from becoming a law in Massachusetts!
