POPE FRANCIS ON THE EUCHARIST



“The action of the Holy Spirit and the efficacy of Christ’s own words uttered by the priest make truly present, in the form of bread and wine, His Body and His Blood, His sacrifice offered on the cross once and for all. Jesus was very clear about this. We have heard how St. Paul, at the beginning, recounts Jesus’ words: ‘This is my body, this is my blood.’ ‘This is my blood, this is my body.’ It is Jesus Himself Who said this. We must not have strange thoughts: ‘But, how come something that...’ It is the body of Jesus; it finished there! Faith: faith comes to our aid; with an act of faith we believe that it is the body and blood of Christ. It is ‘the mystery of faith,’ as we say after the consecration.” (©Aleteia).

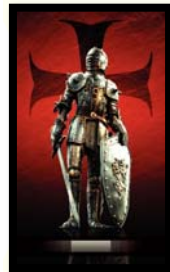
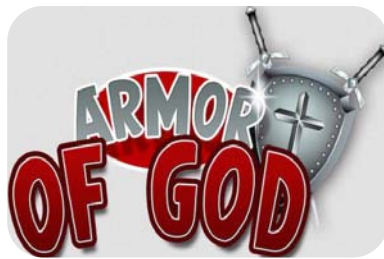

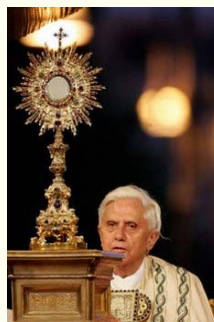

TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

"Precisamente porque se trata de una realidad misteriosa que rebasa nuestra comprensión, no nos ha de sorprender que también hoy a muchos les cueste aceptar la presencia real de Cristo en la Eucaristía. No puede ser de otra manera. Así ha sucedido desde el día en que, en la sinagoga de Cafarnaúm, Jesús declaró abiertamente que había venido para darnos en alimento su carne y su sangre (Jn 6, 26-58)... La Eucaristía sigue siendo "signo de contradicción" y no puede menos de serlo, porque un Dios que se hace carne y se sacrifica por la vida del mundo pone en crisis la sabiduría de los hombres. Pero con humilde confianza la Iglesia hace suya la fe de Pedro y de los demás Apóstoles... Renovemos también nosotros esta tarde la profesión de fe en Cristo vivo y presente en la Eucaristía. Sí, "es certeza para los cristianos: el pan se convierte en carne, y el vino en sangre". (Papa Benedicto XVI, Homilía de Corpus Christi 2007).
