

What to do when someone dies at home:

1) Call Police (Police will call the Coroner)

2) Call Priest

3) Call Funeral Home (to come get the body)

Be prepared to answer the following:

A) What type of service do you want? (Regular funeral or cremation?)

B) Will you give permission to prepare body for burial? (Embalming or other?)

C) When would you like to come to the Funeral Home to finalize the arrangements?

4) Call relatives

5) Go to Funeral Home appointment to:

A) Decide on:

- (1) date and time of funeral**
- (2) what church will do the service?**
- (3) will there be a wake?**

B) Bring:

- (1) clothing for the deceased**
- (2) a good color picture**
- (3) social security number**
- (4) name of parents of the deceased**
- (5) place and date of birth**
- (6) insurance policy**
- (7) cemetery plot title**
- (8) deceased funeral wishes (if done)**
- (9) newspaper article information**
 - (a) names of living and deceased relatives**
 - (b) special clubs or organizations**
 - (c) in military?**
 - (d) where to send donations or flowers**
