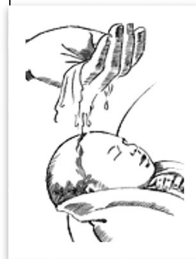
Our Lady has said members of prayer groups are open to God’s will in their hearts.
