St. Mary Parish Crab Feed

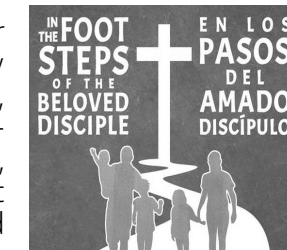
