### Fr. Nicholas Duggan

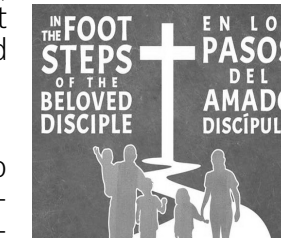
