All are invited to attend this Mass on January 22; 12:10pm at the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament for the full restoration of the right to life on the Diocesan Day of Reparation. It is held on the 46<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the U.S. Supreme Court's decision on Roe v. Wade.
