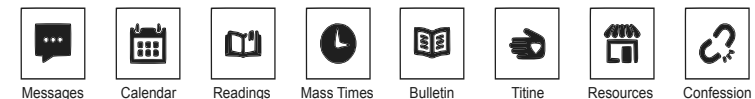

medication techniques (Leyva, D-Chino) with minor amendments. SB 24 continues to require the on-campus health centers of public universities in California to offer abortion-inducing drugs like RU-486.

SB 24 also invites student health centers to offer abortion counseling services to students but is specifically written in such a way to exclude pro-life counseling. This bill fails to allow students the opportunity to know their life-affirming options.

Besides the moral significance of this bill, SB 24 puts the health of college women at a greater risk. Chemical abortion can be a painful and traumatic experience that if not administered at the appropriate time could lead to complications and even place the women's life at risk.

Ask your elected representative to vote NO on SB 24
