Alice has left this life after a very brief battle with pancreatic cancer. She was one of the foundations of our St. Vincent de Paul Conference. Alice joined the conference and became Treasurer almost twenty years ago. Upon her retirement Alice began visiting the poor with home visits. Alice was kind, compassionate, generous with her time and funds, a passionate advocate for the poor and always willing to go the extra mile to help folks. She would sometimes spend all day trying to find a resource to help families if the society could not. As Vincentians, our challenge is to see Christ in the people we serve and Alice always tried to see our Lord in folks even when they were difficult to deal with and impatient with our assistance.

Alice was also very active in the Parish - she had a hard time saying no to anyone that needed help. Alice helped count money Monday mornings, participated on a new social justice committee that Fr. Vaughan formed and was very active in taking communion to the home bound. Her deep belief in God and in our responsibility to help our brothers and sisters motivated her always in her daily activities.
