Let us set aside at least one hour a week in front of the Blessed Sacrament praying for peace in the world. **A Silent Adoration is held every Wednesday evenings in the church from 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. closing with Benediction.**

Please keep the inside church doors closed during and after Mass. If you need to open the doors to assist people coming in and out please hold open and then close them promptly afterwards. It is important that we conserve our heat during these colder months and air conditioning in the heat.
