Parish News

All parishes in our diocese have been directed by Bishop Soto to cancel all "non-essential large indoor gatherings" through the month of March in response to the Coronavirus outbreak.

-We are canceling our March 25th communal Lenten Penance Service.

-Removing the holy water from the small fonts by church doors and our large baptismal font, religious education programs are suspended through the month of March.

-We will also need to cancel the Lenten Fridays Soup and Stations of the Cross.

Bishop Soto is also, issuing a decree dispensing those 60 years of age and older and those with chronic medical issues from the obligation of Sunday Mass. This will remain active until further notice. Those who are sick or demonstrating symptoms are reminded that they are already dispensed from the Sunday obligation.
