Changes in Celebration of Mass On July 13, 2020, our Governor stated that Places of worship have been closed to indoor celebrations.

Act of Spiritual Communion:

O my Jesus, I believe that you are truly present in the Most Holy Sacrament of the altar. I love you above all things and desire to receive you in the Eucharist. Since I cannot receive you sacramentally at this time, I beg you, dear Lord, come into my heart spiritually and refresh my soul. I adore you with profound reverence; I embrace you and unite myself wholly to you. Never permit me to be separated from you.

Reflection on 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time

How would you answer if God said to you, "Ask anything of me, and I will give it to you?" In today's readings, Solomon responds to that question with a request for an understanding heart to distinguish between right and wrong. That's not what I would have asked for, but then I don't have Solomon's wisdom. He knew the 10 commandments and priests who could help him navigate the Hebrew Scriptures' remaining 613 commandments. So he knew right and wrong. But he didn't want to just know laws. He tried to understand what was right and wrong. Knowing and understanding are different. Seeing this difference may have been Solomon's true wisdom. We could use his wisdom today as our faith formation programs, and Catholic schools are adapting to pandemic realities.

The word education comes from two Latin words; educare, meaning training, and educere, meaning drawing out. Educare is focused on knowing the tradition. Memorization is important. Educere seeks understanding and demands critical thinking and questioning to draw out meaning. It's not an either-or proposition. We need to both bring out the new and preserve the old as Jesus suggests in today's gospel. Also, he also tells us that the Kingdom of God is like a wealthy merchant who sells everything to buy land where he knows treasure is buried. We must do the same.

Our treasure is Jesus Christ. Catholic education and faith formation programs must continue to make Christ known, and discipleship understood so we can proclaim and work to establish the Reign of God as he wills us to do. That will mean that we invest precious time and dollars in faith formation and education. Our teachers and catechists will need new technology and lots of professional development. Demands on parents, especially single parents, will be crushing. We have to ease their educational burdens as best we can. We will figure out a way because as the Book of Kings tells us, God will give us "... a heart so wise and understanding. . ."
