Reflection

In graduate school, I took two semester courses devoted to the study of the Passion Narratives. I concluded that the richness and wisdom of these ancient traditions are inexhaustible. Peter's denial is a case in point.

In our culture, denial is symptomatic of the many addictions that plague us. It is also often a public relations ploy used by politicians accused of sexual misconduct or corruption. But that is not what Peter is experiencing in today's gospel passage. Within hours of professing undying loyalty to Jesus, fearful of the crowds, he disassociates himself from Jesus. But then, Peter is moved by remorse rather than self-defense. He changes course again and becomes the apostle we know today. We all fall short and in one way or another and feel guilt or remorse over something we've done. We can deny our responsibility and make excuses for our behaviors, or we can face the pain of remorse. It can be a step toward healing. It can also lead to repentance, a stronger belief in the Good News, and a greater commitment to our proclamation of the Reign of God.
