In-Door Masses Schedule:

Holy Saturday, Easter Vigil 5:30pm in English and 7:30pm in Spanish; Both Mass will be Live-Streamed.

Easter Sunday at 8:00am and 10:30am in English, 12:30pm and 7:00pm in Spanish; 2:30pm in Hmong.

Live-Streaming of the 10:30am and 12:30pm Masses will continue for the foreseeable future on YouTube, Facebook, and through our website.

Daily Mass at 8:00am Monday through Friday will be celebrated.

We can accommodate only 71 people at each mass; No one in the chapel!! Due to COVID -19, once we reach 71 people and/or mass has started, the doors will be closed and no one else will be let inside.

Reservations will need to be made by Noon on Thursday every week. The same restrictions and recommendations apply from when we were open before.

Reflection Finding Christ

In our Easter Sunday morning reading from John's Gospel, three disciples are searching for Jesus. Mary Magdalene, Simon Peter, and the disciple whom Jesus loved begin their search at the grave. Jesus was just crucified and buried, so the tomb is the logical place to look. But they find the tomb empty. The disciple whom Jesus loved makes an extraordinary profession of faith. Somehow, he believes Jesus has risen. The rest of the disciples will have to see before they believe.

If we read further in chapter 20 of John's gospel, we will discover Jesus approaching Mary remains outside the tomb as she weeps for him. She cannot recognize him until he calls her by name. Later, the Risen Christ will also make himself known to the other disciples as they huddle in a hidden room hiding in fear. In the end, all experience the risen Christ and will spend their lives proclaiming his gospel.

The lesson may be that seek Christ, he may not be where we expect to find him. In fact, we won't find him at all. He will find us. We may not recognize him right off the bat. But we will know him when we hear him call out our name.
