Reflection: Trouble with Ghosts

In today's Gospel passage the disciples huddled in a small room fearful of opponents and confused by the eyewitness reports of a resurrected Jesus. Suddenly, Christ appears and wishes them peace. Troubled, they think they are confronting a ghost. But Jesus convinces them he is real. He then interprets all of scripture in light of his resurrection and tells them to go out and give witness to the resurrection to all the nations.

All baptized Christians are disciples and we too bear witness to the Risen Christ. In the light of his resurrection we reinterpret scriptures anew and compelled to proclaim the Risen Christ to the world. How? It could be something as simple as being kind and welcoming to the people in our lives. Maybe we can join the Saint Vincent De Paul Society and serve people in need right here in our neighborhood. We would love to have you. We can engage in any of the ministries in our parish. Beyond that, there are other helping agencies in our community. We could also get involved in systemic change and proclaiming the gospel by helping the California Catholic Conference or Catholic Charities. There are all kinds of ways in which we can proclaim the resurrection outside of church life.

Christ challenged and commissioned his disciples to get out of that hiding room and proclaim the gospel to all Nations. All of us, not just the ordained, share the responsibility and authority to apply scripture to our lives and bear witness to the gospel. Anything less would mean settling for ghosts and missing the Risen Christ.
